A FEW RULES FOR YOUR SAFETY AND THE ENJOYMENT OF THE GAME

1. PLAY ONLY WHEN SUPERVISED BY GROUP STAFF OR GLLM STAFF.
2. No stick head (broom end) is to be raised higher than the waist. This will (should) result in a time penalty and the penalty box, as an ice hockey.
3. No baseball swings with the broom when attempting to hit the ball.
4. Do not try to hit the ball before it lands on the ice. If the ball is thrown into play, the ball must be on the ice before a player may swing at it.
5. CHECKING (hitting another person with your body): Do not check hard. Checking for the sake of hitting someone is not the way to play the game. The supervisor may penalize the player for a rough and/or unfair check.
6. If a hard ball is used (other than a "Nerf Ball"), do not "lift" the ball with the stick.
7. Kicking the ball or other players is a foul, subject to the supervisor's choice of penalty.
8. Tripping an opponent is a foul, subject to the supervisor's choice of penalty.
9. The supervisor is not to play the games so that he/she may concentrate on supervising.

SUGGESTIONS:

- A. If there are more players than sticks, rotate players in as the games goes along. Every five minutes is a good interval.
- B. If the score is going to be important, the supervisor should keep score.
- C. Remember, the game is for fun and enjoyment. Don't ruin it by being over aggressive.
