Celebrating Pr. Naomi Mahler’s Impact: Advocate of the Year Award

At the 2023 Green Lake Lutheran Ministries Annual Meeting, Pr. Naomi Mahler was honored posthumously with the “Advocate of the Year” award. This award recognizes individuals who passionately and eloquently speak about GLLM, with the goal of engaging new audiences.

Pr. Naomi, who passed away in October of 2023, had a long and impactful connection with GLLM. It started in college when she worked on summer staff, continued through her involvement as a parish pastor, and was lived out in her call as the Executive Director of GLLM before moving on to other ministries. Past her own involvement, her husband (Todd Lynum) and daughters (Grace and Sophia Lynum) also worked at camp in various roles. A hallmark of her work at camp was her laser focus on what was most important, the hospitality that she shared with old and new friends of the ministry, and her passion for unpacking the Gospel in vibrant ways.

“Camp takes these young, talented, ‘work in progress’ adults [camp counselors] - provides safe places for them to learn and grow. Allows them to unpack their questions, and then fosters exponential growth of faith and character” shared Pastor Naomi during a visit with Executive Director Travis Aufderheide.

“The world needs camp! And if something can be done with my death to inspire involvement, I want to do it!” shared Pr. Naomi. Thus, the Pr. Naomi Mahler Endowment fund was created with the purpose of funding the hiring of summer staff at Green Lake Lutheran Ministries. Gifts were made by the family as well as from 209 donors / families in her memory.

Pr. Naomi Mahler’s recognition as the “Advocate of the Year” serves as a testament to her profound dedication to GLLM’s mission of inviting all to experience the life changing love of Jesus in vibrant settings in community and creation. And that commitment continues to inspire our work.

During the past year, camp staff have engaged in an ongoing conversation about “What is GLLM?” The term “outdoor ministry” is often used to describe us within the church community, and I must admit, it feels incomplete. Are we an outdoor summer camp? Yes...AND. Are we a retreat center? Yes...AND. Are we a mission trip organization? Yes...AND. This isn’t the whole story.

Over the past few years, GLLM has made substantial investments in our ministries. We have formed numerous partnerships, restructured our site utilization, recruited specialized staff members dedicated to uncommon roles, constructed the Cottages and did a major capital investment at Shores of St. Andrew Bible Camp, took on a national ministry presence through the acquisition of Serve Boldly, among so many other significant investments. With all of these initiatives in motion, do you understand the “debate” surrounding the question “What is GLLM?”

Now, I won’t hide from the fact that the above investments are inspiring for some but also concerning for folks who feel we are moving away from our once sole identity as a “Bible Camp.” Let me be very clear—all of our investments have only enhanced our ability to serve children, youth, and families while growing summer camp ministry! Said differently, we can walk AND chew gum.

Rather than, “What is GLLM?” I think the question for us to consider is, “Who did God create us to be?” Now that is a fun conversation. My answer? **God created us to be BOLD.** Bold in our pursuit of faith and even bolder in our commitment to invite all individuals to experience the life-changing love of Jesus in vibrant settings in community and creation.

It is not a given that when an organization makes changes versus the status quo, that folks will buy in. And that makes your trust to do this transformative work such a blessing. I cannot wait to see what God creates us to be next!

Standing on Holy Ground

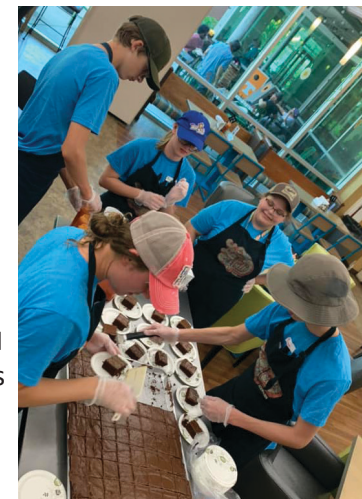
After fundraising and planning, packing and preparing, it was finally time for our group of 6 youth and 2 adult leaders to leave home for Nashville, TN. We knew our time with Serve Boldly would be a week of meaningful and memorable learning and service among God's people in that place.

So as we gathered at the airport at 4:15am with bleary eyes and a carry-on each, with a team of TSA agents ready to usher us into the gate area, I turned to Exodus 3. We heard the story of Moses encountering God in a burning bush. In verse 5: "God said, 'Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.'"

We were about to remove our own shoes, as per government regulation. But this time we considered it to be more than that. Taking off our sandals wasn't just the usual inconvenience; it also served as a symbol of recognition of the holy ground on which we'd soon stand—just as Moses took off his shoes to stand barefoot before a burning bush in acknowledgment of God's holy presence.

Our destination of Nashville was also holy ground—not because that particular city is holier than any other, but because we knew God would already be there. And God's people were already at work participating in acts of divine mercy, love, and justice. We were blessed to be welcomed into that work. During our week, we became aware of the stories and struggles of brothers and sisters in Christ who live very different lives than we do. We learned more about God, ourselves, and the world. We experienced the profound significance of serving others in Jesus' name and living our faith by putting love into action.

If you're considering doing Serve Boldly, do it! And then take off your shoes, for you will be standing on holy ground.

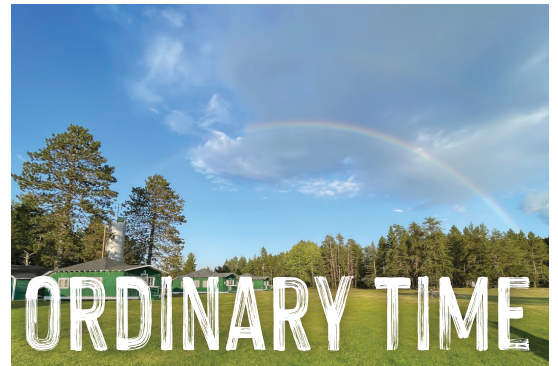
