CAMP JOY REGISTRATION

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Camp Joy is primarily designed for individuals who can care for their own personal needs and do not require a great deal of one-on-one supervision. If individuals are in need of one-on-one assistance in their daily routines, Care Givers are required to attend. Camper attendance requires the permission of a physician. Please fill out the enclosed forms and send them in with your camp registration. Campers that have required medical staff in home must be accompanied at camp. Day camp staff is not responsible for one-on-one medical treatment.

Registration Options:

Our camp has programming Monday to Thursday, 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM, and Friday 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

Registration is open for: 1) a full week at camp with no overnight stays, or 2) the full week including overnight accommodations. Please check a box below.

- Option 1:** Full Camp, Day Only – no overnight, camp runs Monday to Thursday, 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM, and Friday 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM • Fee: \$380
- Option 2:** Full Camp with Overnights - Monday to Thursday, 9:00 AM – 8:00 PM, and Friday 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM (no overnight Monday) • Fee: \$480
