Due to the rapidly increasing COVID positivity rate in our state, the two main rental spaces at Green Lake Bible Camp - the Chrysalis House and Medayto Lodge - will be operating under the latest guidance that requires gatherings to be only with those from the same household. Effective today, November 20th, this will be the policy for all groups wishing to reserve space at GLLM until conditions warrant loosening restrictions once again.

If you had a space reserved here at camp in the near future, we will be in touch if these updated guidelines do not fit your group's needs. If that is the case, we will work with you to find a time when we are able to safely gather again! **While these decisions continue to be difficult to make, we know that we all play a part in caring for our neighbor and supporting our health care systems by helping to reduce opportunities for the virus to spread.**
