

Your Guide to Medayto Lodge

Parking

1. Please park in the seven spots right in front of Medayto.
2. Additional cars, boats & trailers can be parked in front of the playground or in the Chapel's gravel parking lot.

Heating, Air, and Fireplaces

1. There are four digital thermostats in Medayto. They are located next to the fireplace in the main living area, one in the sun porch area, one at the top of the staircase, and one in the far west bedroom area (off the kitchen); each digital thermostat has a diagram explaining how to adjust it.
2. For heat, switch the digital thermostat to heat and press the up or down button to set to your heat preference.
3. For air, switch the digital thermostat to cool and press the up or down button to set to your cool preference.
4. Fireplace use- There are two different fireplaces in Medayto. The first one is located in the main living room area. To turn this fireplace on, simply push the black ignition button located below the vent at the bottom of the fireplace. The second fireplace is located in the sun porch. To turn this fireplace on, set the non-digital thermostat up until it comes on.

Lights, Fans, and Outlets

1. All light switches are labeled with the light or outlet it goes to.
2. The light switch for the sun porch is located outside the glass doors. This switch has a slide bar dimmer alongside the switch.
3. The fan in the main living room can be turned on by the dial located to the right of the fireplace. Turn the dial to the desired speed.
4. The fan up stairs is on a switch and the speed is controlled by a slide bar alongside the switch.
5. Some outlets are controlled by a switch and some are not. All the outlets and switches are labeled telling which outlet goes with which switch. If an outlet isn't working, check that it is not a switched outlet.
6. The breaker box is located behind the framed print in the hallway off the kitchen.

Laundry and Cleaning

1. There is a laundry room in Medayto.
2. You may use the washer/dryer as needed; we do not provide laundry detergent.
3. The cleaning supplies are located under the stairs; you may use the supplies as needed.
4. We supply toilet paper, dish soap, hand soap, and garbage bags.
5. Please refrain from using bathroom linens to wipe up coffee and other spills. Please use kitchen towels for this purpose. Thank you.

Garbage and Recycling

1. There are garbage cans throughout the entire house. If the garbage becomes full, please put it in the blue dumpster in the parking lot (summer) or the east side of the Chrysalis House (winter).
2. Additional garbage bags can be found in the cleaning supply closet under the stairs.
3. We recycle! The recycle bins are located in the laundry room. Please put the recycling in the correct bins.
Please empty them in the recycling receptacles near the cardboard dumpster/Chrysalis House.

Furniture

1. Please do not move the furniture around at Meydato Lodge. If you need furniture moved, please contact a staff member.

Stereo

1. The stereo is located on the second floor in the loft area.
2. Press the power button on the stereo to turn on.
3. The stereo has a six-disc CD player as well as a tape player.

Water Equipment and Outdoor Activities

1. Seasonally, there is a dock outside Medayto that is for your use. The rest of the camp will not use your dock.
2. The main site has a water trampoline; feel free to use this trampoline when not in use by campers.
3. In and outside the boat shed on the main site there are canoes, kayaks, water toys, paddles and life jackets. If not in use by campers, please feel free to use the equipment. It is extremely important that **after each use** of any item ie.. kayaks, canoes etc.. it be immediately put back in storage. Do not park kayaks or canoes, as well as other items, in front of Medayto Lodge they must be returned as soon as you have finished using that item.
4. There is no lifeguard on duty.
5. The boat access is located less than a mile down the road towards the west or town.
6. We do not have a boat lift. We ask that you take your boat out of the water each night. This is for the safety of your boat and our dock. We are not responsible for any damage incurred to your boat.
7. There is a gas grill and a charcoal grill.
8. If you would like to use the charcoal grill, you are responsible for the charcoal.
9. We will provide the propane for the gas grill; if the tank is empty or near empty please contact your host to re-fill it for you.
10. Remember when using the gas grill; please make sure to turn off the propane tank.
11. There is a campfire pit located next to the beach.
12. Extra firewood is located in the garage off the parking lot inside the front walk-in door.

Camp Activities

You are more than welcome to participate in activities that take place at camp.

Summer Time

1. Morning worship is at approximately 9:15 am Tuesday-Thursday and 10:30 am on Friday. Traditional Worship takes place 6:00 pm on Saturday and 8:30 am on Sunday, Memorial Day through Labor Day. All morning worship services are held at the Chapel.
2. Campfires take place at 9:30 pm Sunday-Tuesday. Thursday campfire will take place after the Christ Walk. Please let a staff member know if you plan to attend so they can tell you where it will be located.
3. Vespers, a more reflective worship service, takes place on Wednesday at 9:30 instead of campfire at the chapel.
4. The Athletic field, Gaga Ball Pit and basketball /volleyball court are free for your use when they are not being used by the campers (balls are located outside the canteen).
5. We have a 9 hole disc golf course that you may use. A map is included in your Welcome Packet. The discs are located outside the canteen, between the Chapel and road.

Winter Time

1. We have broomball, a tubing hill, snow shoes, and cross country skis (there is a limited amount of snow shoes and skis). Contact your host to check out the equipment.
2. There is a waiver for broomball and the tubing hill that you must complete prior to using the equipment. Please contact your host for this form.

Storm Shelter and Fire Safety

1. There is a storm shelter located in the cleaning supply closet under the stairs.
2. Clear all objects from the floor to locate the trap door.
3. There is a light inside the storm shelter as you go down the stairs.
4. As this isn't the most comfortable place to be, you are more than welcome to join the campers in the storm shelter on the main site.
5. A staff member will come to tell you that the rest of the camp is going into the storm shelter (we require the campers to go into the storm shelter for storm warnings).
6. There are three doors in which to escape from fire. The main door, the sliding deck door, and one by the far west bedrooms.
7. There are three fire extinguishers. They are located by the fireplace in the main living area, one by the west bedrooms, and one at the top of the stairs.

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Drug Use

1. Alcoholic beverages are allowed: however, we expect guests to practice discretion in their alcohol consumption, to not become intoxicated, and to be courteous to other guests and residents of the camp. GLLM reserves the right to deny alcohol privileges to any group for any reason, and to expel groups that abuse the privilege.
2. Smoking is allowed outdoors on the deck.
3. Drugs are not permitted on camp property.

Refrigeration & Ice

One refrigerator/freezer is in the house. It has a built-in ice maker. We do not provide additional refrigeration space or ice.

Re-Booking Policy

Due to the high demand to rent Medayto Lodge we have put in a new re-booking policy. It reads as such:

You may book a year, to the date in advance. You must do this by either talking to the registrar in person or calling the registrar on the phone (320)796-2181. You may contact the registrar between the hours of 8am to 3:30pm Monday-Friday. *Summer months and holidays are the busy times of year for rentals. Other dates are usually easily obtained.*
